

Video Lessons: Safeguarding Guidelines for Parents/Carers

Student safeguarding is the highest priority during any remotely streamed video lesson. The following points must be observed to protect both the student and the teacher.

- **Please make sure there's an adult present for the duration of the lesson.**
- **Dress** Students must be wearing suitable clothing for the lesson. Normal day to day clothes are fine.
- **Location** The lesson should take place in a 'public' room in the house such as the living room, kitchen or similar. The bedroom is not suitable.
- **Communication** Please do not use the instant message feature whilst in a lesson. The teacher will always contact parents/carers first when it is the agreed lesson date and time, please don't try to initiate any other meetings with the teacher.
- **Language** We expect students, and any family member in the background, to use appropriate language during the lesson.
- **Privacy**
 1. You must not pass the teacher's email address or mobile number (where provided) on to the student
 2. You must not share any passwords
 3. You must not share or redistribute any content.
- Any parent/carer or any other person who has a safeguarding concern relating to the teacher, should report their concern to the Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO).
